

MLM The Game vs. Diamond Destination

MLM The Game is a simple approach that concentrates on the fundamentals of success while engaging participants in the learning process. At the core, there are many similarities to Diamond Destination and MLM The Game.

The purpose of MLM The Game is to have a virtual experience of building a network marketing company, which is similar to the purpose of Diamond Destination. The delivery method, game system, and content is all very different.

The first difference is simplicity. MLM The Game does not require a calculator or usage of any play money, which Diamond Destination does.

The second difference is score card based. A major part of both games is the scorecard. The MLM The Game score card shows through colorful graphical content how the business grows, requires people to write their Why and dream up their future compensation, and in turn attract that reality. The Diamond Destination score card or Networking Worksheet is more complex and dependent on the players ability to thoroughly understand the directions given.

The third major difference is content. The content of Diamond Destination is situational, consisting of "You get this... or You do that..." statements. Situational statements mostly tell the player what happens, they teach, but there is less room for interactivity. Similar to a book it has great teachings and information, however this type of question does not allow for high engagement or easy interaction between the game and player. This approach leaves the interaction level up to the players, and does not encourage learning and interaction. MLM The Game takes an entirely different approach. In addition to the small percentage of situational statements, MLM The Game has T/F questions, multiple choice questions, and open ended engaging questions. These types of questions and content engages the mind, the players personal creativity, and involves players in the process. It is based on multiple principles of accelerated learning technology.

The most important thing to know is that you will have fun with both games. You will have great time with Diamond Destination, and you will have a great time with MLM The Game. You have many books on your book shelf, and we believe you will benefit from having as many games as possible on your book shelf as well. One seminar, one trainer, one book, or one game will never teach you everything.

The first difference is simplicity and complexity. MLM The Game does not require a long learning curve, a live facilitator, or a calculator, which the NetMillionaire Training System does for optimal play. The NetMillionaire Training System is more advanced, and has much more

content and information for the experienced networkers. MLM The Game is simple, and offers an easy introduction to network marketing which will not be overwhelming to a beginning networker.

The second difference is score card based. A major part of both games is the scorecard. The MLM The Game score card shows through simple graphical content how the business grows, requires people to write their Why and dream up their future compensation, and in turn attract that reality. The NetMillionaire Training System tally sheet has much more content which gives the players more insight and a more clear vision into their future business building possibilities.

The third difference is content. Both MLM The Game and the NetMillionaire Training System take an interactive approach. The NetMillionaire Training System uses mostly creative open ended engaging questions, with no real right or wrong answers. This is rewarding if there is a facilitator that knows the right answers, has the right insights, or if there are truly experienced networkers present. If everyone playing are beginning networkers some great topics may be left un discussed or possibly wrongly answered. Back to the simplicity, MLM The Game has a small percentage of situational statement type questions where players have no choice or interaction, it also has many T/F questions, many multiple choice questions, and several open ended engaging questions similar to the NetMillionaire Training System. These types of questions and content engages the mind, the players personal creativity, and involves the players in the process. Both games are based on multiple principles of accelerated learning technology.

The fourth difference is time needed to play. MLM The Game is simple, and if only 3-4 people play it will usually take less than 2 hours to finish the game. In regards to the NetMillionaire Training System, once the game is learned, or if a facilitator is used, playing time will be much longer due to all the open ended questions. There is a timer to help the game move along, but when an experienced person shares his or her wisdom we want to listen, and we want to learn, so it may still be hard to keep the flow going. Game play of the NetMillionaire Training System moves forward quicker with a facilitator that knows how the game works because he or she will also push people to continue playing versus just keep speaking about 1 game card. Keep in mind however that finishing a game like this may not be your top reason for playing, yes, winning is fun, but learning and team building is really the top benefit of both games.

If you are looking for an all day seminar game to fill a full day event, and you have facilitators able to help you run the entire event the NetMillionaire Training System is a great option. If you want to fill a small event slot of 2 hours, or for a quick & easy way to show network marketing to a prospect or play with your downline then MLM The Game may be a better choice.
