

I would like to attend the Webinar tonight. How do I go about doing that?

Go to www.networkingtimes.com and create an account (easy and FREE). Log in and click on University, Click on Course List and select tonight's Webinar. Click on the Webinar title and you will be sent to a registration page. Enter your name and email address, submit and you will receive a confirmation email with a link giving you access to the meeting room at the time of the Webinar. Several reminder emails will be sent, including one day and one hour before the actual Webinar.

Once you log into the meeting room, you will be connected to video slides and audio using your computer's microphone and speakers (VoIP). A headset is recommended. After joining the Webinar, you may select "Use Telephone" to attend by phone.

I can't log into the website, even with the right login and password

Please make sure you have cookies enabled for our web site. As a quick test, in Internet Explorer, go to "Tools > Internet Options..." in the menu bar. Then click on the "Privacy" tab and move the slider down to the very bottom so it says "Allow All Cookies." (Be sure to reset this back to your original setting afterwards.) Then try to log in again at <http://www.networkingtimes.com> on the right hand side.

I'm having problems logging into my e-listening courses. What do I do?

You can see your e-listening courses by logging into your account at www.networkingtimes.com and clicking the link at the top that says "My List of Enrolled Classes and e-Courses." Then you can click on the white e-listening button to start the audio.

If you still have problems, the most common issues users have is usually not having the most recent version of realplayer (www.real.com) installed or having a firewall (windows or personal) blocking realplayer from accessing the server. If this is the case, you will most likely see a blank white screen with potentially some icons and triangles at the bottom. Also try disabling any popup blockers if you don't get any new window.

As a NU student, I have free access to e-learnings. However to access them I have to go through the shopping cart and check out, while amount to pay is \$0.00. Is there a way around this?

There is another way to get access to your e-learnings without going through the checkout process. You can log into our website and click on the "University" link on the top navigation bar in between "Reprints" and "Loyalty". Then you can click on the "e-Learning" button to get the list of all of our archived courses which you can listen to for free.

This method of registering will not require you to go through the checkout process. We have been working to try to fix the catalog portion of our website to not 'checkout' university members, but we ask that you use this workaround instead until we are able to address it.
